TRAINING CERTIFICATES - ARMED GUARDS

Dear Colleague,

We have been made aware of some instances where certificates detailing skills and qualifications of armed security guards recruited by Private Maritime Security Companies (PMSCs) to work on ships in the piracy High Risk Area are not being checked with the desired level of thoroughness.

UK ship operators and PMSCs are reminded of the importance of checking these documents carefully. The checks should include contact with the training body named as issuing the certificate to confirm details shown and document authenticity.
