Graham Kerr Resume

Graham Kerr was commissioned into the Royal Artillery in 1969 having spent two years at the Royal Military Academy Sandhurst. He enjoyed a full career in the Army, retiring in 2004 as a Brigadier. The highlights were: serving as a Troop and Squadron Commander with 22 SAS; having the privilege of commanding 29 Commando Regiment RA (his first Regiment as a junior officer); some demanding staff appointments at every level; and gaining wide ranging operational experience in the Middle East, Northern Ireland and the Balkans. His final tour was for 3 years as Commander of the British Military Mission in Kuwait, which reinforced his level of experience of operating in the Middle East. He was involved with the development of the International Code of Conduct and its follow on work.
