

Richard Lovell-Knight is Director Risk at Pilgrims Group, previously Director Global Operations and President Pilgrims Afghanistan. During nine years in Pilgrims he has directed projects for UK Government and hundreds of organisations in UK, Europe, USA and various complex, conflict-affected environments around the world.
